The Seventeenth Annual WELV Conference will bring education leaders to Charlottesville for two days of dynamic presentations and in-depth dialogue. Combining formal speeches with panel discussions, small-group break-out sessions, and social and professional networking opportunities, this year's conference will provide women leaders with the opportunity to gain a deeper understanding of issues of importance to them as leaders so that they can help to create a better tomorrow for all the students of the Commonwealth.



This year's **KEYNOTE** will be presented by **CAROL ANN TOMLINSON**, the Chair of Educational Leadership, Foundations, and Policy, and co-director of the Institutes on Academic Diversity at the Curry School of Education, UVA. Recently named one of the two most influential higher education voices in the United States in Psychology and the 16th most influential voice in ALL education-related fields, Dr. Tomlinson has written more than 300 books, book chapters, articles, and other materials for educators. Dr. Tomlinson's Keynote will center on her latest book, *Leading for Differentiation: Growing Teachers who Grow Kids*, which explores how school leaders set the course for positive change by creating structural supports that help teachers grow as differentiators so that their students will thrive as learners.

The Conference will also feature a presentation by **NOELLE ELLERSON**, the Assistant Director of Advocacy and Policy for AASA, who will discuss the latest developments in federal education legislation. Participants will also have the opportunity to attend panel discussions and engage in numerous informal discussions with other attendees on issues of importance to women leaders. Break Out Sessions were one of the most popular features of last year's Annual Conference, so there will be even more Break Out Sessions offered at this year's event. Participants who would like to present a Break Out Session at this year's WELV Annual Conference are encouraged to visit the WELV website in early November for more information on the process for submitting a presentation proposal.
